1st Meeting:

On Tuesday, March 6th, starting at 5:00 PM, an open community conversation facilitated by Councilwoman Cori Schumacher about the Palomar Airport Master Plan and EIR will be held at the Community Room at Alga Norte Park.

The purpose of this conversation is to encourage open, respectful dialogue around the technical concerns our residents have with the County's draft Master Plan and EIR. I want to ensure I have ample opportunity to listen to our residents and to discuss your technical concerns prior to the March 13 Council agenda item where Council will be reviewing city staff's comment letter on the draft Master Plan and EIR. The city's comment letter will be submitted to the County by March 19. It is my intention to ensure our residents' concerns are adequately incorporated in the city's comment letter.

This meeting is open to anyone, regardless of residency or opinion on the airport expansion/extension. Also, this event will be broadcast live via Facebook.

2nd Meeting:

As mentioned in Councilwoman Cori Schumacher announcement, there will also be a Carlsbad City Council Meeting **at** Carlsbad City Council Chambers, 1200 Carlsbad Village Drive, Carlsbad, CA on March 13th regarding the city's comment letter to the County on the Airport Draft Master Plan. That letter will be submitted to the County on March 19.
