Carlsbad's 21.53.015 states any amendment to CUP 172 requires a majority VOTE of Carlsbad's citizens!**

Carlsbad Officials Need to Enforce Ordinance 21.53.015 and CUP 172!

January 30, 2018, in a public forum, San Diego County stated it has no intention of asking Carlsbad to amend CUP. It went on to say, the County and the new Master Plan is in full compliance with Carlsbad Laws.

In 2001, McClellan-Palomar Airport's runway was extended from 4,700 feet to 4,897 feet without a majority vote of Carlsbad citizens. TODAY, 78 passenger size commercial jets are operating out of an airport **only approved** by Carlsbad citizens for small recreational aircraft!

The County extended the runway, BUT Carlsbad Citizens never voted and approved that extension! Now the County is trying to do that again!

Ever wondered why the same size home cost more in Encinitas than Carlsbad?

According to the real estate community, it is because of the airport factor.

Now the County wants to reduce Carlsbad, Oceanside , San Marcos and Vista home values even more.

According to studies commissioned by the Orange County Board of Supervisors, as airport noise increases 1 decibel (dB(A) property value will drop 1.35% or a 20 dB(A) increase will result in 27% drop in home values.

That said, it is projected if the County is successful in extending the runway, the average noise level around the airport will raise over time to 20 dB(A) and eventually to 40 dB(A).

The County's new airport plan is to lengthen the runway up to 800 feet and moved it north to free up more maneuver room for larger aircraft. According to Supervisor Bill Horn, the new San Diego County's next 20 year plan is to turn McClellan-Palomar into a *"huge commercial operation."* Is he saying a mini John Wayne Airport?

If this happens, the result will be 100 or more passenger commercial jets using our airport and Tons and Tons more pollution and greatly increased noise pollution!

**Carlsbad APPROVED ONLY a 4,700 foot runway, NOT today's 4,897 foot runway!
Now the County plans to extend the runway up to 5,697 feet! John Wayne is 5,701 feet!**
